

COURT APPROVED PROTOCOL

Uncashed cheques

1. All cheques issued or re-issued by the Administrator after 2018 shall be made to expire within 60 days. This shall be printed on the cheque and on the correspondence accompanying the cheque. The correspondence accompanying the cheque shall also state that the cheque should be cashed immediately as stale-dated cheques will not be re-issued.
2. Where the Administrator has mailed a cheque to a claimant and it has been returned as undeliverable and the claimant has not provided the Administrator with updated contact information, the Administrator will:
 - (a) make reasonable efforts to locate the claimant through internet searches or other available means, and
 - (b) where possible, contact the claimant's physician to locate the claimant.
3. Where the Administrator is unable to obtain updated contact information for the claimant after completing the steps in 2 (a) and, where possible, 2 (b) above, the Administrator shall cancel the cheque. The monies will be deemed to be unclaimed and the claimant shall have forfeited any entitlement to a further payment from the settlement. The monies allocated to this claimant shall be returned to the settlement fund.
4. Where the Administrator has mailed a cheque to a claimant, but it has remained uncashed for 3 months from its issuance the Administrator shall put a stop payment on the cheque. The monies will be deemed to be unclaimed and the claimant shall have forfeited any entitlement to future payments from the settlement. The monies allocated to this claimant shall be returned to the settlement fund.
